VI. COA 14-067

Request to make changes to existing doors and windows on east wall of former US Open retail space. This property is located at 1 Carolina Vista and can be identified as Moore County Parcel ID# 25800.

Chad Hall, Senior Planner read the staff report and confirmed that adjacent property owners were notified and that the property had been properly posted.

Bob Farren recused due to his affiliation with the Resorts.

Tesse Chao, Architect was present to answer any questions or address any concerns of the Commission.

After discussion, Jack Farrell made a motion to issue a Certificate of Appropriateness and adopt the Findings of Fact to make changes to existing doors and windows on east wall of former US Open retail space at 1 Carolina Vista; Molly Gwinn seconded the motion. The vote was 5-0.

Request to construct master suite and garage addition in rear yard, attached to existing home by enclosed breezeway. This property is located at 105 Woods Road and can be identified as Moore County Parcel ID# 26262.

Chad Hall, Senior Planner read the staff report and confirmed that adjacent property owners were notified and that the property had been properly posted.

Marcel Goneau, Contractor was present to answer any questions or address any concerns of the Commission.

After discussion, Molly Gwinn made a motion to issue a Certificate of Appropriateness and to adopt the Findings of Fact to construct a master suite and garage addition in rear yard at 105 Woods Road; Jack Farrell seconded the motion, which was unanimously approved. The vote was 6-0.
