New Business

a) Village Acres:

Molly met with Bill Keith for the following discussions:

Regarding the Irrigation at NW corner of Spring Lake and Hwy 15-501, Mr. Keith believes there is a meter there and would like a conduit under Spring Lake from one side to the other to provide irrigation. Kevin will check on this.

Regarding the Hillsides on Forest at Hwy 15-501 at the entrance to #6, Mr. Keith noted that there is poor drainage. He suggested that perhaps plantings could help the problem. Molly asked the committee members to go by and offer any ideas for improvement.

b) Spring planting in the circle:

Judy reported that the DOT budget is tight due to the Hurricane and the budget impasse. Therefore, they cannot afford to pay for the plants involved in the traffic circle this spring. Judy suggested we contact the Pinehurst Garden Club and other garden clubs to help support the up to \$5,000 it will take to provide the plants. If Garden Clubs come together we could possibly put up a sign to acknowledge their support. DOT will do the actual planting, but The Village will need to fund the plants.

Molly has sent letters to local garden clubs to see if there would be interest in joining us. She suggests perhaps \$2500 from Beautification Committee; \$1500 from the Village; and the balance from the garden clubs.

Peggy moved that the Beautification Committee fund half of the cost of the plants up to \$2500. Molly seconded the motion. The motion passed.
