Approval of Minutes:

Budget-

Kevin distributed the budget and noted recent expenditures: Christmas Decoration Contest advertising \$741.; Flowers for the Traffic Circle \$2299.25; Ritter triangle plants \$242.94. Operating budget remaining balance is \$20,087.99

Planning for fiscal year 2021 is just beginning. Molly asked that we request a budgeted amount for replacement of the bows on the Christmas wreaths and perhaps an amount to adapt the light posts to light the wreaths.

- a) Projects Update
 - Railroad trestle Jeff continues to get estimates. He currently has two possibilities and is looking for them to refine their estimates.
 - Midland/McKenzie at Hwy 5 corners Kevin described a proposed plan for this area including plantings and retaining wall. DOT must give approval. It will take approximately \$2000 to get irrigation under the road.

 Lake Hills/Monticello at Hwy 5 corners – Molly asked that committee members look at this area and think about possibilities.

b) Christmas Projects

Decoration Contest Review –

Bert distributed a summary of the contest and took questions and suggestions for next year's contest. Discussion followed. Bert will retrieve the signs from this year's winners.

Peggy and Brenda will continue with the committee and it was proposed to ask Amy McKenzie to lead the project this coming year.

c) Christmas Lighting in the core Village

There was review of this year and ideas put forth for the future. Suggestions included more lights, up lighting trees, lights on wreaths, and reaffirming that all lights should be clear for Christmas.
