

ORDINANCE #99-12:

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING OF THE PINEHURST MUNICIPAL CODE AS IT PERTAINS TO SECTION 7, SCHEDULE X AND SCHEDULE VIII OF CHAPTER VII WITH REGARDS TO POSTING OF SPEED LIMIT AND STOP SIGNS WITHIN THE TAYLORHURST SUBDIVISION.

THAT WHEREAS, the Village Council of the Village of Pinehurst adopted an Ordinance dated October 20, 1980, regulating various traffic controls for the purpose of prescribing regulations governing conditions hazardous to life and property or detrimental to the safety or welfare of its citizens; and

WHEREAS, the Chief of Police has recommended that certain Stop Signs and Speed Limit Signs be erected in the vicinity of those streets described in Sections 1 and 2 below, in the interest of Public Safety;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ESTABLISHED by the Village Council of the Village of Pinehurst, North Carolina in regular session assembled this 17th day of May, 1999, as follows:

SECTION 1. That Schedule VIII, Section VII of the Pinehurst Municipal Code is hereby amended by adding the following:

1. "A STOP sign shall be installed on Valley Road and its intersection with Beaver Lane."
2. A STOP sign shall be installed on Magnolia Avenue and its intersection with Beaver Lane."

SECTION 2. That Schedule X of Section 7 of the Pinehurst Municipal Code is amended by adding the following:

25 MPH Speed Limit be posted in the area more commonly known as the Taylorhurst Subdivision.

SECTION 3. That pursuant to the above referenced Sections of the Pinehurst Municipal Code, the Chief of Police is hereby authorized, empowered, and directed to have STOP signs and Speed Limit signs erected as cited in Section 1 and 2 of this Ordinance.

SECTION 4. That this Ordinance shall be and remain in full force and effect from and after the date of its adoption and the erection of the necessary signs.




