

ORDINANCE #99-25:

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING FUNDS FOR EXPENDITURES OF THE FIREMEN'S RELIEF FUND FOR PINEHURST, NORTH CAROLINA.

THAT WHEREAS, the purpose for which some appropriations in the 1998-1999 Budget were authorized have changed, necessitating the addition of funds from other sources;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ESTABLISHED by the Governing Body of the Village of Pinehurst, North Carolina, that the following amendment be made retroactive to the annual budget ordinance for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1999:

SECTION 1. To amend the General Fund, the expenditures are to be changed as follows:

Revenues and expenditures will be posted for the same amount, therefore there will be no impact on the budget, other than to ensure that sufficient funds are appropriated to cover the expenditure amount.

SECTION 2. Copies of this budget amendment shall be furnished to the Clerk, to the Governing Board, to the Budget Officer and to the Finance Officer for their direction.
