ORDINANCE #96-1:

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER V, ANIMAL CONTROL, OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE VILLAGE OF PINEHURST, NORTH CAROLINA.

THAT WHEREAS, the Village Council adopted an Animal Control Policy on October 20, 1980, such ordinance codified as Chapter V in the Pinehurst Municipal Code; and

WHEREAS, said Policy has been amended from time to time as circumstances and the best interests of the Community have required;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ESTABLISHED by the Village Council of the Village of Pinehurst, North Carolina in Special Session assembled this 22nd day of January, 1996, as follows:

SECTION 1. That the following sections of the Municipal Code are amended as follows:

(1) Section 5-3.2 <u>Apprehension and Notice;</u> <u>Identifiable Dog.</u>

Change the last sentence in this paragraph to read:

The apprehending officer shall endorse the date, time and place of each apprehension of an "identifiable dog" on record in the files of the Village Police Department.

(2) Section 5-3.3 Repeated Offenses.

Change the paragraph to read:

If an "identifiable dog" is found running at large, or acting as a public nuisance on any occasion after the second offense and the second notice thereof, the third offense and each apprehension thereafter will be deemed and found to be a violation of this Section and punishable as provided in Section 5-6 hereof. A record of each offense shall be made by the apprehending officer.

SECTION 2. That this Ordinance shall be and remain in full force and effect from and after the date of its adoption.
