ORDINANCE #96-28:

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CAPITAL PROJECT FUND FOR THE VILLAGE HALL CONSTRUCTION FOR THE VILLAGE OF PINEHURST, NORTH CAROLINA.

THAT WHEREAS, the amount necessary for some appropriations in the 1996-97 Budget has changed, necessitating the addition of funds from other sources;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ESTABLISHED by the Village Council of Pinehurst, North Carolina, in regular session assembled on the 18th day of November, 1996, that, pursuant to Section 13.2 of Chapter 159 of the General Statutes of North Carolina, the following capital project ordinance is hereby amended:
