## ORDINANCE #95-11

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A CAPITAL PROJECT FUND FOR THE VILLAGE HALL AND POLICE DEPARTMENT CONSTRUCTION FOR THE VILLAGE OF PINEHURST, NORTH CAROLINA.

THAT WHEREAS, the Village Council of the Village of Pinehurst has studied the long-range needs for administrative office space; and

WHEREAS, after careful deliberation of the alternatives available, the Village Council has selected a site which it feels is adequate in both size and location;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ESTABLISHED by the Village Council of Pinehurst, North Carolina, in regular session assembled on the 17th day of April, 1995, that, pursuant to Section 13.2 of Chapter 159 of the General Statutes of North Carolina, the following capital project ordinance is hereby adopted:

**SECTION 1.** The project authorized is the construction of a new Village Hall and Police Station project between the Village of Pinehurst and Anderson Architecture.

SECTION 2. That the proper officers of the Village of Pinehurst are hereby authorized, empowered and directed to proceed with the project within the terms of the contract, and within the budgeted funds appropriated herein.

**SECTION 3.** The following revenues are anticipated to be available to the Village of Pinehurst to complete the project:

SECTION 5. The finance officer is directed to report monthly on the financial status of this project. She shall also keep the Village Council informed at each regular meeting of any unusual occurrences.

**SECTION 6.** The Budget Officer is directed to include a detailed analysis of past and future costs and revenues on this capital project in every budget submission made to the Village Council.

**SECTION 7.** Copies of this capital project ordinance shall be made available to the budget officer, and the finance officer for direction in carrying out this project.

SECTION 8. That this Ordinance shall be and remain in full force and effect from and after the date of its adoption.
