

ORDINANCE #95-13:

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING FUNDS FOR THE CAPITAL PROJECT FUND FOR THE VILLAGE HALL RENOVATION PROJECT FOR THE VILLAGE OF PINEHURST, NORTH CAROLINA.

THAT WHEREAS, the amount necessary for some appropriations in the 1994-1995 Budget has changed, and it has become necessary to increase certain appropriations in the 1994-1995 Budget; and

WHEREAS, the tax rate will remain unchanged;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ESTABLISHED by the Village Council of the Village of Pinehurst, North Carolina in Regular Session assembled this 17th day of April, 1995, as follows:

SECTION IV. That the Village Budget Officer is hereby further authorized, directed, and empowered to transfer funds within departments to the proper object of expenditure as needed, making a full report to the Village Council of said transfer on a monthly basis.

SECTION V. That this Ordinance shall be and the same is hereby effective from and after the date of adoption for a period ending June 30, 1995.

SECTION VI. This Ordinance is passed and adopted this 17th day of April, 1995.
