ORDINANCE #95-14:

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING FUNDS FOR EXPENDITURES OF THE CAPITAL RESERVE FUND FOR THE VILLAGE OF PINEHURST, NORTH CAROLINA.
