Public Hearing:

The purpose of this public hearing is to consider an Official Text Amendment to the Pinehurst Development Ordinance in order to amend Section 10.2.15.9(4) —Required Improvements for Major and Minor Site Plans. The amendment will add a provision to not require the installation of street sidewalks for new developments that are prohibited from having vehicular access along a specific street. The applicant is the Village of Pinehurst.

After discussion, Joel Shriberg made a motion to approve the Text Amendment Section 10.2.15.9(4) to add a provision not to require the installation of street sidewalks for new developments that are prohibited from having vehicular access along a specific street as this proposal takes into consideration the changing needs and desires of the community and is therefore deemed to be in accordance with the 2010 Comprehensive Plan. Achieving goals in accordance with the Comprehensive Plan is considered reasonable and in the best interest of the public and to recommend to Village Council; Jay Snyder seconded the motion, which was unanimously approved.
