

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE PINEHURST MUNICIPAL CODE AS IT PERTAINS TO INDIVIDUAL OR PRIVATE SEWAGE-DISPOSAL SYSTEMS AND WATER SUPPLY SYSTEMS.

THAT WHEREAS, the Village Council of the Village of Pinehurst, under the Pinehurst Municipal Code, governs conditions hazardous to life and property or conditions detrimental to the safety and welfare of its citizens; and

WHEREAS, changing conditions have required a review pertaining to individual or private sewage-disposal systems and water supply systems; and

WHEREAS, the Village Council has determined that it is in the best interest of the citizens of Pinehurst to add Section 9-5 to the Pinehurst Municipal Code;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ESTABLISHED by the Village Council of the Village of Pinehurst, North Carolina, in special session assembled this the 24th day of October, 1994, as follows:

SECTION 1. That Section 9-5, of the Pinehurst Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

9.5 PRIVATE SEWAGE-DISPOSAL SYSTEMS AND PRIVATE WATER WELLS.

No private systems shall be interconnected with any public water supply. Private sewage-disposal shall not be used unless a public system is more than 300 feet away from the dwelling or structure. Where public water supply is available, wells may only be used for non-human consumptive purposes.

9.5.1 Where public water is available, private wells shall only be used for non-potable purposes.

9.5.2 Private wells for non-potable purposes must obtain Zoning Compliance Permit.

9.5.3 No private well system shall be interconnected with any public water system.

9.5.4 Private sewage disposal shall not be installed unless a private disposal system is not available within 300 feet of the closest lot boundary needing service.

9.5.5 Violations and Penalties. Any person, firm, or corporation who shall be adjudged to have violated this Section shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and shall, upon conviction, be punished by a fine of fifty (\$50.00) dollars or imprisonment.

SECTION 2. All laws and ordinances or sections thereof in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. Adopted this 24th day of October, 1994.


