

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING SPEED LIMITS IN THE NEWLY ANNEXED AREA OF PINEDALE SUBDIVISION

THAT WHEREAS, the Village Council has the authority under Section 7-7 of the Municipal Code of the Village of Pinehurst to establish speed limits on streets in the municipal system; and

WHEREAS, the Village Council has the authority under Section 7-9 to direct the Police Chief of the Village of Pinehurst to erect speed limit signs in the corporate limits of Pinehurst; and

WHEREAS, the streets in Pinedale subdivision became part of the municipal system upon annexation on March 31st, 1994; and

WHEREAS, the streets in Pinedale Subdivision were posted by NCDOT with 25 m.p.h. speed limit signs prior to annexation;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ESTABLISHED by the Village Council of the Village of Pinehurst, North Carolina, in Regular Session assembled this 20th day of June, 1994, as follows:

SECTION 1. That the speed limit on the streets contained within the Pinedale subdivision shall be 25 mph.

SECTION 2. That the Police Chief of the Village of Pinehurst is hereby authorized to inspect the existing signs to ascertain that they have been placed in a proper manner, and in a manner that adequately informs motorists that the speed limits within the subdivision are 25 m.p.h.

SECTION 3. That the Police Chief of the Village of Pinehurst is hereby authorized to erect 25 m.p.h. speed limit signs where he deems appropriate within the Pinedale subdivision.

SECTION 4. That all ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed and declared null and void from and after the date of adoption of this ordinance.

SECTION 5. That this ordinance shall be and remain in full force and effect from and after the date of its adoption and the erection of the appropriate traffic signs.




