ORDINANCE #94-16

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING SPEED LIMITS IN THE NEWLY ANNEXED AREA OF PINEHURST TRACE SUBDIVISION

THAT WHEREAS, the Village Council has the authority under Section 7-7 of the Municipal Code of the Village of Pinehurst to establish speed limits on streets in the municipal system; and

WHEREAS, the Village Council has the authority under Section 7-9 to direct the Police Chief of the Village of Pinehurst to erect speed limit signs in the corporate limits of Pinehurst; and

WHEREAS, the streets in Pinehurst Trace subdivision became part of the municipal system upon annexation on March 31st, 1994; and

WHEREAS, the streets in Pinehurst Trace Subdivision were posted with 20 m.p.h. speed limit signs prior to annexation;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ESTABLISHED by the Village Council of the Village of Pinehurst, North Carolina, in Regular Session assembled this 20th day of June, 1994, as follows:

SECTION 1. That the speed limit on the streets contained within the Pinehurst Trace subdivision shall be 20 mph.

SECTION 2. That the Police Chief of the Village of Pinehurst is hereby authorized to erect two 20 mph speed limit signs on Pinehurst Trace Drive. One will be placed at the entrance of Pinehurst Trace subdivision, and one will be placed at the intersection of Pinehurst Trace Drive and Robin Lane.

SECTION 3. That all ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed and declared null and void from and after the date of adoption of this ordinance.

SECTION 4. That this ordinance shall be and remain in full force and effect from and after the date of its adoption and the erection of the appropriate traffic signs.

SECTION 5. Adopted this 20th day of June, 1994.
