ORDINANCE #94-2:

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE PINEHURST MUNICIPAL CODE REGARDING TRAFFIC CONTROL DESIGNATIONS

THAT WHEREAS, the Village Council of the Village of Pinehurst adopted an Ordinance dated October 20, 1980, regulating various traffic controls for the purpose of prescribing regulations governing conditions hazardous to life and property or detrimental to the safety or welfare of its citizens; and

WHEREAS, changing conditions have required review of speed limits in the areas of Monticello Road and Lake Hills Road in the Village of Pinehurst; and

WHEREAS, the Village Council of the Village of Pinehurst, by Ordinance #93-19, approved a six month trial of a speed limit of 25 mph as recommended by the Chief of Police and residents of the area, due to topographic conditions, pavement width, and densities in these areas;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ESTABLISHED by the Village Council of the Village of Pinehurst, North Carolina in regular session assembled this 21st day of February 1994, as follows:

SECTION 1. That the Village Council pursuant to Sections 7-7 and 7-9 of the Pinehurst Municipal Code, hereby orders and directs the posting of 35 mph speed limit signs for the following streets and hereby orders, directs and empowers the Chief of Police to have the same erected as soon as possible.

Monticello Road from Highway 5 to End Lake Hills Road from Highway 5 to Saint Andrews Drive

SECTION 2. That this Ordinance shall become effective from and after the date of its adoption, and the erection of the necessary speed limit signs by the Chief of Police.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance adopted this 21st day of February, 1994.
