## Hometown Holiday Drive Through

Join us at the Cannon Park Community Center on December 4 from 5:00pm-8:30pm for holiday fun! This drive through event will allow families to view Christmas scenes on display, pick up a treat bag for each child, and drop off letters to Santa.

Q: Is this event free?

A: Yes, this event is free and no tickets are required!

Q: It says the event is from 5:00-8:30pm. Should we plan to stay the whole time?

A: This is a drive-thru event, so once you've driven through, you're free to go. The Pinehurst Police Department will help direct traffic that evening.

Q: What precautions are you taking to make sure everyone is safe from COVID-19?

A: Attendees must stay in their vehicles the entire time. In addition, any staff members who approach vehicles will be appropriately masked and gloved.

Q: Can my children sit on Santa's lap and give him their letters?
