- b) Litter Pick-up Amy will take the lead on a subcommittee with Molly and Janice offering to assist. Jeff noted that DOT had been hiring prisoners to pick up on highways so perhaps that could be something to investigate for more dangerous highly travelled areas.

- d) Christmas decoration judging Amy approved an announcement for the October newsletter. She had invited three judges and would like to have two more. Particulars were discussed.
- e) Amy will allocate areas of the Village for committee members to monitor the needs and make suggestions for the Beautification Committee.

New Business

- a) Plantings on 211 with DOT VOP budgeted funds for plantings along 211. Another round will go in this fall/early winter near HWY 5. Gaps will be filled in.
- b) Scheduling placement of bows and lights on wreaths Mary Hall said bows can be delivered when we are ready. Dee asked for four volunteers to decide on logistics of putting on lights and bows. There are 104 wreaths, each getting 2 bows which means 208 bows. There are also two 100 light strands for each wreath.
 - Dee, Janet, Molly, Janice will meet to decide on logistics, timing, etc. Mary Hall will have bows available for the meeting.
- c) The Beautification Committee meeting is rescheduled for October. The Committee will meet on October 12 rather than the 5th.
- d) Other items:
 - Matt Whitaker has suggested we put drip irrigation in our hanging baskets. Dee said Kevin was going to research the possibility.
 - With the announcement of the USGA and Opens coming to town this committee needs to think big into the futue and decide how to make this town sparkle.
