Pinehurst 4th of July Parade Guidelines

Route

- Lineup will take place on Magnolia Road near the Pinehurst Village Hall at 395 Magnolia Road. Parade begins at the intersection of McCaskill Road and Magnolia Road toward the Village Center, taking a left on Dogwood, right on Market Square, left on Magnolia Road and left on Chinquapin. Parade ends just after passing the Holly Inn.

Check-in/Line up

- Line up begins at 8:30 AM on Magnolia Rd.
- All parade participants must arrive and check-in by 9:30 AM
- **The parade will begin rolling at 9:45 AM sharp!**

Walkers

- If you are walking in the parade, you may park your vehicle in the parking lot near Village Hall, Rassie Wicker Park, or the Cannon Park Community Center. Parking on private property is not allowed.

Safety

- **To avoid the risk of possible injury, the throwing of candy or any other item from a vehicle or float is strictly prohibited. Any items you wish to distribute to the crowd **MUST** be handed out from someone walking alongside your entry. We do not want any children running into the streets in front of cars.**
- Any items being distributed must only be passed out while walking in your assigned parade spot. No items should be passed out before the start of the parade or following the conclusion of the parade. At no time should items be passed out in Tufts Memorial Park, this is prohibited.
- Entries with children under the age of 18 must also have parents or other adult chaperones riding and or walking alongside who provide supervision.

Flow of the Line of March

- Keep up with the unit in front of you at all times.

Animals

- Entries involving animals of any kind must provide their own clean-up, or “pooper scooper”.
- Our pet parade will be walking the parade route beginning at the Dogwood/Market Square intersection. If you would like to participate in that portion of the parade please fill out the “Pet Parade Application”.
