

RESOLUTION #21-24:

A RESOLUTION OF ADOPTION – FORT BRAGG REGIONAL LAND USE ADVISORY COMMISSION BYLAW REVISIONS.

THAT WHEREAS, the Fort Bragg Regional Land Use Advisory Commission (RLUAC) was established in 1991 at the conclusion of the Joint Land Use Study to serve as a regional forum to advance planning and communication between the military bases and the surrounding local governments; and

WHEREAS, RLUC was established in 1991 under the authority of NCGS 160A-461 for the purpose of interlocal cooperation and was subsequently incorporated as a 501(c)3 membership-based non-profit organization in 2004; and

WHEREAS, RLUAC is the leading advocate for coordination and collaboration between Fort Bragg and local governments on issues related to compatible growth and environmental sustainability in the North Carolina Sandhills region; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Pinehurst is a member of RLUAC; and

WHEREAS, on November 19, 2020, and on August 19, 2021, RLUAC approved amendments to modernize its governance structure and implement the organization’s strategic plan; and

WHEREAS, Approval of two-thirds of the local government members of the Commission is needed to officially amend the bylaws.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Village Council of the Village of Pinehurst, hereby approves the revised RLUAC Bylaws as amended on November 19, 2020, and on August 19, 2021 at the Quarterly Membership meetings of RLUAC.
