







Glossary

Arch - is an opening in a building that is curved on top



<u>Cornerstone</u> - a large stone often found in the corners of buildings with construction information and a date

<u>Longleaf Pine</u> - is a tall brown flaky/rough barked tree native to the south with very long green needles (longer than your hand)

<u>Pattern</u> - are things that repeat like windows in a building or images/shapes <u>Sprouting</u> - to begin to grow or grow from seed with buds and shoots above ground
