1. Call to Order.

Mayor Strickland called the meeting to order at 03:00 PM.

Review Minutes from May 16, 2022 Meeting.

The committee reviewed the notes from the May 16, 2022 meeting.

Ms. Lalor asked that three items discussed by Mr. Adkins at the May 16, 2022 meeting be added to the minutes.

MyVOP Application Presentation – Jill Lazusky.

Jill Lazusky provided an overview on the MyVOP app the Village uses, including the reasons for its usage, how to check open / already submitted requests, request category descriptions and importance of selecting the correct category for the request, available functions and features, an explanation of the staff procedures upon receipt of a MyVOP request / complaint, reviewed State versus Village Right-of-Way areas, discussed the defunct Community Watch program and the possibility of reviving the program, the possibility of using MyVOP for a Short Term Rental database depending on legislative regulations adopted in the future, discussed the difference between police emergencies and code violations, the volume of requests / complaints on MyVOP, and having a Staff demonstration of MyVOP for any interested neighborhood.

Other Business

Village Council and Mr. Sanborn will review items for future discussion between now and the next meeting in September.

5. Neighborhood Reports.

- Ed Balkovic Pinehurst Trace: discussed the recent daytime break-in that occurred (issued a neighborhood advisory / best practices notice to help prevent break-ins and submitted a request on MyVOP for police report), and reviewed the recent Memorial Dr. turn lane / signal work done and the potential hazards the new turn lane will create for residents entering / leaving the neighborhood.
- . Bert Higgins Doral Woods: discussed the potential relocation of the Public Services facilities, the impact this will have on the surrounding

neighborhoods, and asked that information regarding the relocation be shared directly with the surrounding neighborhoods as it comes available.

- Barbara Reining CCNC: nothing to report, neighborhood is happy.
- Debbie Lalor Downtown Residential Area: discussed concerns over the new NAC procedures / policies and reluctance from residents to
 participate should the new NAC procedures / policies being discussed be implemented; recurring issues such as speeding, stop signs,
 traffic patterns, and STR's; discussed concerns over parking in the area surrounding the Resort / Women's Exchange / future USGA site;
 asked for clarification on the meeting minutes and records management procedures / policies for the NAC as it stands currently; and reiterated the desired inclusion to the May 06, 2022 meeting minutes of 3 items discussed by Mr. Adkins at that meeting.
- Tony Elms Donald Ross: thanked Jeff Batton for his recent help with a storm water issue in the neighborhood, asked for clarification on the new NAC procedures / policies to be presented at the meeting in September, discussed concerns residents have over participation in the NAC should the new procedures / policies be implemented, expressed the desire of the neighborhood / HOA board is to continue to be able to control the flow of information from the Village to the residents in the neighborhood, and asked for clarification on what will happen should the neighborhood choose not to participate in the NAC or be unable to find a representative.
- Kevin Fitzpatrick Pinehurst No. 6: discussed the upcoming Adaptive Open being hosted by the neighborhood, preparations underway
 with many volunteers being local residents, and limited neighborhood facility / program availability from around July 15th to the 21st;
 presented the outcome of a recent neighborhood survey on walkways and the desire of the neighborhood to install a walkway system.
- Paul Spurgeon Cotswold: thanked the Village for recent storm culvert cleaning, and asked the Village to be aware of the new EPA PFAS
 regulations and to coordinate with Moore County on how the new regulations will be implemented and water quality monitored.
- Lee Thomas Clarendon Gardens: discussed a recent power outage in the area resulting in the neighborhood going without power for
 roughly 4 hours (water pressure / availability was not as adversely affected by this power outage as it had been with past power
 outages), and the need to determine if the neighborhood is a suitable staging ground for a permanent power company generator.

The next NAC meeting will be held on Monday, September 19, 2022 at 3:00 p.m. in the Assembly Hall.

The meeting adjourned at approximately 04:50 p.m.




