Saint Patrick's Day Parade Guidelines

Check-in/Lineup

- Line up begins near Village Hall, 395 Magnolia Road, Pinehurst NC 28374, in the following order:
 - WALKERS leading the parade lining up closest to McCaskill Rd.
 - **GOLF CARTS** in the middle of the parade lineup with staging near Village Hall.
 - **CARS/TRUCKS** at the end of the line up with stage on Rassie Wicker Dr.
- All entries must enter Magnolia Road from Rattlesnake Trail or Rassie Wicker Drive. Magnolia Road at the intersection of McCaskill Road will be closed.
- The check in point is at the intersection of Magnolia Road and Rassie Wicker Drive. Staff will be easily identified by a bright yellow safety vest.
- The Pinehurst Police Department, Fire Department, and/or Parks & Recreation staff will lead each group.
- All participants must arrive and check-in by 9:30am.
- The parade will begin rolling at 9:50 AM sharp!

Walkers

- If you are walking in the parade, you may park your vehicle in the parking lot near Village Hall, Rassie Wicker Park, or the Cannon Park Community Center. <u>Parking on private</u> <u>property is prohibited.</u>
- Any items (such as candy) must be passed out along the parade route and not thrown into crowds.
- Always keep up with the group in front of you. No intentional stopping along the parade route.
- Entries involving animals of any kind must keep pets leashed or in a carrier at all times. Entries must provide their own clean-up, or "pooper scooper".

Golf Carts/Cars/Trucks

- All drivers must show staff at the check in point a valid driver's license.
- All entries must match their submitted application, any changes must be approved by staff before the application deadline (Friday, February 24).
- Applications must include all vehicle tags and/or golf cart permit numbers.
- Entries must keep up with the flow of the parade but stay behind the Village of Pinehurst staff leading the group.
- No materials may be thrown from your golf cart/car/truck along the parade route. If you
 wish to pass out items, you must change your entry to "walking".
- Participants must remain in their vehicle OR on the golf cart at all times through the end of the parade. Walking entries will not mix with vehicle entries.
