

RESOLUTION #13-13:

A RESOLUTION ADOPTING A POLICY REGARDING THE ALLOCATION OF WATERSHED INTENSITY ALLOCATIONS.

THAT WHEREAS, watershed protection regulations are designed to protect the drinking water supply and to protect water quality within the Village of Pinehurst and it's surrounds; and

WHEREAS, the southern portion of Moore County including that within Pinehurst and its Extra Territorial Jurisdiction (ETJ) obtains its drinking water from both surface waters and ground waters; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Pinehurst has a limited amount of acreage in which it can issue Special Intensity Allocations; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Pinehurst can better maintain stormwater systems and facilities that are located within its Corporate Limits; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Pinehurst can utilize its municipal authority and police powers within its corporate limits to better protect illegal discharges and possible sources of contaminants; and

WHEREAS, dense or urban type development are better served by the public with sanitation, police, fire and other police powers when located within a municipal boundary; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Pinehurst has a need to maintain and/or increase employment opportunities and property tax base;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Village Council of the Village of Pinehurst, North Carolina in Work Session assembled on the 12th day of March, 2013, as follows:

SECTION 1. It shall be the Policy of the Village of Pinehurst to only allocate Special Intensity Allocations to properties that are located within the corporate limits of Pinehurst or to properties which have an active voluntary annexation petition to the Village of Pinehurst.

SECTION 2. That this Resolution shall be and remain in full force and effect from the date of its adoption.
