6) Governing Board Membership

In North Carolina, MPOs are typically represented by two principal committees: the Technical Coordinating Committee (TCC) and the Transportation Advisory Committee (TAC) (now called the Governing Board or MPO Board). The Governing Board provides policy direction based on input and technical information from TCC, for the planning process, public involvement, and guides the development of a comprehensive multi-modal transportation planning (MTP and CTP) and program for the MPO (TIP).

Based on 49 US Code 5303, a MPO should consist of local elected officials and appropriate state officials. Each jurisdiction will appoint a primary and alternate representative that meets the qualifications of membership. Until a MOU and bylaws are approved, a temporary Governing Board needs to be chosen.

Governing Board Action: Approve Governing Board membership of one representative from each jurisdiction and the NCDOT Board of Transportation member.

7) Metropolitan Planning Area Boundary (MPA)

Based on 23 US Code 134, a MPA shall encompass at least the existing urbanized area based on the 2020 census and the contiguous area expected to become urbanized within a 20-year forecast period. The map with the boundary dated 5/22/23 was approved by all jurisdictions except the county. The approvals by the jurisdictions met the 75% threshold.

Governing Board Action: Approve SAMPO Metropolitan Planning Area.

8) Lead Planning Agency

A lead planning agency is designated for each MPO and provides staff support for MPO functions. Pinehurst has volunteered to be the Lead Planning agency for the MPO.

Governing Board Action: Approve Pinehurst as SAMPO Lead Planning Agency.

9) Transportation Coordinating Committee Membership

In North Carolina, MPOs are typically represented by two principal committees: the Technical Coordinating Committee (TCC) and the Transportation Advisory Committee (TAC) (now called the Governing Board/MPO Board). The TCC has the responsibility of making technical recommendations to the Governing/MPO Board.

Based on 49 US Code 5303, a MPO should consist of local elected officials and appropriate state officials. Each jurisdiction will appoint a primary and alternate representative that meets the qualifications of membership. Until a MOU and bylaws are approved, the temporary Transportation Coordinating Committee membership needs to be selected which would become the MPO TCC if no changes are required.

Governing Board Action: Approve MPO's Technical Coordinating Committee membership.
