- Under the Consent Agenda, Council approved:
 - Approval of Village Council Meeting Minutes

- Council approved Resolution 24-23 honoring Mr. Jeff Batton by a vote of 5-0.
- Council reviewed the Quarterly Financial Statements as of March 31, 2024.
- Council held a Public Hearing on the FY 2025 Budget.
- Council approved the Contract for Legal Services for FY 2025 by a vote of 5-0.
- Council approved Ordinance 24-10 amending the Library Expansion Capital Project Fund Budget by a vote of 5-0.
- Council approved Resolution 24-22 amending the Service Awards and Retirement Recognitions Policy by a vote of 5-0.
- Other Business: Mayor Pro Tem Taylor shared information from the May 28, 2024, Moore County Board of Commissioners meeting regarding water and Senate Bill 166.
 - Under the Work Session, Council:
 - Discussed the possibility of accepting Royal Oak Townhome Development roads.
 - Received an update on the 2024 US Open preparations.
 - Held a Closed Session pursuant to North Carolina General Statute §143-318.11(a)(5) to establish, or to instruct the public body's staff or negotiating agents concerning the position to be taken by or on behalf of the public body in negotiating the price and other material terms of a contract or proposed contract for the acquisition of real property by purchase, option, exchange, or lease.

 - Agreed to reorder the Regular Meeting agendas so the Public Comments period is closer to the beginning of the meeting.
