Mr. Scott Walston, NCDOT Transportation Planning Division Representative, reviewed a PowerPoint presentation on the Metropolitan Transportation Plan (MTP) / Comprehensive Transportation Plan (CTP) development process focusing on the development requirements and schedule.

Mr. Walston further stated the Committee and Governing Board will need to work to gather travel demand model and Travel Analysis Zone (TZA) information to use for possible future modeling steps.
