The Council, the Village Manager and the Village Attorney discussed the status of the litigation between Mr. Mike McCrann and the Village of Pinehurst; legal proceedings regarding the Traditions of Old Town Development, and the claim concerning the Village of Pinehurst by Mrs. Rose Swaringen. Regarding the McCrann litigation, Mr. Newman reported that he fully expected McCrann and the other plaintiffs to appeal the Superior Court decision in favor of the Village and the other defendants.
