#### MAYOR VIRGINIA F. FALLON CALLED THE MEETING TO ORDER.

The Council, the Village Manager and the Village Attorney discussed the status of a possible claim regarding the Village's first floor retail ordinance, and the status of the litigation between Mr. Mike McCrann and the Village of Pinehurst. The Village Attorney reported that a Mr. Dean Whitenhorn (spelling is an approximation) had complained to him about the first floor retail regulations in the Village Commercial Zoning District Classification. Mr. Newman stated that he would keep the Council apprised of the status of this potential complaint. As of this date, there is no news on the decision of the North Carolina Court of Appeals in the McCrann litigation.
