Councilmember Lapins seconded the motion which carried unanimously by a vote of 4-0.
- Councilmember Thurman moved to approve the Major Special Use Permit with conditions for the Village Chapel to construct a Learning Center Addition at 10 Azalea Road because all the Standards of Review have been met. The conditions are:
  - Historic approval prior to construction
  - Minor Site Plan approval prior to construction
  - Fire flow approval prior to Certificate of Occupancy approval.
