- David McNeil, District Manager for Duke Energy, discussed Duke Energy's storm planning and the challenges of the most recent winter storm.
- Parks and Recreation Director Mark Wagner relayed a request received from the Knights of Columbus for free utilization of the Fair Barn for a Home, Garden, and Lifestyle Expo. Council unanimously approved the sponsorship of this event according to the newly adopted fee schedule rates for non-profits.
- Council unanimously approved the transfer of a 25+ year old Hurst Rescue System "Jaws of Life" hydraulic pump, manifold, and cutter to Sandhills Community College for use in Emergency Services Training.
- With a vote of 3 to 2, Council approved Ordinance 16-01 Amending the Municipal Code to add stop signs on Monticello Drive.
- Unanimously, Council moved that the mayor, or her designee, be authorized to execute an Interlocal Agreement with Moore County for building inspection services.
- Pat Corso, Executive Director of Partners in Progress, discussed his organization's examination of the growth in southern Moore County.
