

Village Council Summary of Meeting Regular Meeting May 27, 2014

- Council approved a budget amendment for the Moore County Emergency Responders Memorial.
- Council approved a budget amendment for Vehicle Insurance Proceeds.
- Council approved a resolution reappointing Patrick Barry, Carole Boxell, and Carolina Miller to the Village Center Enhancement Committee.
- Council approved a resolution reappointing Brenda Lyne Blackwell to the Beautification Committee.
- Council approved resolutions honoring Nancy Smith and Frank Thigpen for their service on the Historic Preservation Commission.
- Council approved the request from Community Presbyterian Church to operate a parking concession during the 2014 U.S. Open week.
- Council held a public hearing on the voluntary annexation petition from the Citadel Development Group, LLC, for ± 3.2 acres located along Midland Road (a portion of Walker Station).
- Council held a public hearing to discuss the proposed 2014-2015 Fiscal Year Strategic Operating Plan and Budget for the Village of Pinehurst.
- Council approved a resolution establishing a policy for construction to be reviewed by the Village Council that may occur on Village owned property or non-Village owned property if being done for Village use.
- Council approved an ordinance amending the budget for the automated arm solid waste vehicle.
- Council approved an ordinance amending the Pinehurst Municipal Code adding Chapter 120 to prohibit mobile vendors within the Village of Pinehurst.
- Council approved an ordinance amending section 130 of the Pinehurst Municipal Code as it pertains to unmanned aircraft systems.
- Council discussed options regarding the local deer population and determined to create a task force in the upcoming months to look into possible solutions.
- Council approved an ordinance extending the corporate limits of the Village of Pinehurst for the portion of Walker Station Subdivision owned by the Citadel Development Group, LLC as of June 30, 2014
- Council approved an ordinance appropriating funds for Operations of the Village of Pinehurst for fiscal year 2015 and adopting the 2015-2019 Capital Improvement Plan
