



Village Council Summary of Meeting Regular Meeting December 9, 2014

- Council presented resolutions of appreciation to Patrick Barry and Kevin Drum for their service on the Village Center Enhancement Committee.
- Council unanimously approved a resolution reappointing Jeff Batton, Walt Morgan, Randy Murzyn, and Andy Wilkison to the Beautification Committee.
- Council unanimously approved a resolution reappointing Alan Hoy and Mary-Stewart Regensburg to the Community Appearance Commission.
- Council held a public hearing to consider an Official Zoning Map Amendment for 320 Thorne Road from R-20 to R-10. Under Other Business, Council approved an ordinance amending the Official Zoning Map for 320 Thorne Road by a vote of 4-1.
- Council held a public hearing to consider an official text amendment to the Pinehurst Development Ordinance Section 9.4.1.2 (b) Location and Design of Parking Areas/Stacking Lanes to allow parking areas servicing public parks to be graded gravel rather than paved. Under Other Business, Council unanimously approved an ordinance amending the Pinehurst Development Ordinance for this request.
- Council unanimously approved a request from John May, on behalf of East Lake Development, LLC, for an extension of the preliminary plat approval for a 15-lot Major Subdivision located within The Country Club of North Carolina.
- Councilmember John Strickland presented the Deer Management Task Force report and recommendations to the Village Council and the Council held a discussion on each recommendation and allowed for public comments. No action was taken and a decision on the recommendations will be determined at a future Council meeting
- Council unanimously approved a budget amendment to fund 20 body cameras, 2 Segway patrol vehicles, and an additional computer server to store the camera footage for Police Department personnel.
- Under Other Business the Council scheduled their 2015 Quarterly Work Sessions to be on the 3rd Tuesday of January, April, July, and October at 4:30pm.
