

**ORDINANCE #14-21:**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING FUNDS FOR OPERATIONS OF THE VILLAGE OF PINEHURST FOR FISCAL YEAR 2014, REGARDING REVENUES AND EXPENDITURES OF THE GENERAL FUND (SOLID WASTE VEHICLE PURCHASE).**

**THAT WHEREAS,** a Yard Debris Collection report was presented to the Village Council on October 22, 2013 with recommendations to improve the Village's solid waste collection practices through process redesign and automation; and

**WHEREAS,** the study recommended automating the collection of yard debris materials in the Village by January 1, 2015; and

**WHEREAS,** the Village has included the purchase of an additional automated solid waste vehicle in the proposed FY 2014-2015 Budget, but the automated vehicle requires six-months to manufacture deliver; and

**WHEREAS,** in order to automate the collection of yard debris by January 1, 2015, the vehicle must be ordered prior to July 1, 2014;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Village Council of the Village of Pinehurst, North Carolina, in a regular meeting assembled this 27<sup>th</sup> day of May 2014, as follows:

**SECTION 1.** To amend the General Fund with regard to revenues and expenditures, the revenue and expenditure accounts are to be changed as follows:

**SECTION 2.** Copies of this budget amendment shall be furnished to the Village Clerk, Village Manager and to the Financial Services Director for their direction and implementation.




