ORDINANCE #13-14:

AN ORDINANCE CLOSING THE STEAM PLANT PROJECT CAPITAL PROJECT FUND AND AMENDING THE ASSOCIATED TRANSFER IN THE GENERAL FUND FOR THE VILLAGE OF PINEHURST, NORTH CAROLINA.

THAT WHEREAS, the Village created the Steam Plant Project Capital Project Fund by Ordinance #12-33 to assist in the rehabilitation and reuse of the historic property in the Village of Pinehurst more familiarly known as the Steam Plant located in Village Place; and

WHEREAS, the project was funded by a Community Development Block Grant (CDBG), a Main Street Solutions Fund (MSSF) Grant, and a transfer from the General fund; and

WHEREAS, this property is no longer under consideration for development and the associated grants have been forfeited; and

WHEREAS, the Village wishes to close the Steam Plant Project Capital Project Fund;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Village Council of the Village of Pinehurst, North Carolina, in a work session assembled this 9th day of April 2013, as follows:
