

**ORDINANCE #10-48:**

**AN ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH A RESERVE POLICE FORCE  
FOR THE VILLAGE OF PINEHURST.**

**THAT WHEREAS**, the Pinehurst Police Department provides for the public safety and protection of the community; and

**WHEREAS**, the Pinehurst Police Chief deemed that a reserve police force would be beneficial for the community by providing supplemental protections; and

**WHEREAS**, North Carolina General Statute 160A-282 (a) gives authority to municipalities to provide for the organization of a reserve police force made up of volunteer members; and

**WHEREAS**, North Carolina General Statute 160A-282 (b) gives authority to municipalities to provide that, while undergoing official training and while performing duties on behalf of the municipality pursuant to orders or instructions of the Chief of Police of the municipality, reserve law enforcement personnel shall be entitled to benefits under the NC Workers Compensation Act and to any fringe benefits for which such volunteer personnel qualify;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Village Council of the Village of Pinehurst, North Carolina in work session assembled this 28<sup>th</sup> day of September, 2010, as follows:

**SECTION 1.** That it is hereby established within the Village of Pinehurst Police Department, a reserve police force comprised of no more than six volunteer members who shall serve without compensation.

**SECTION 2.** That this ordinance shall be and the same is hereby effective from and after the date of its adoption.

**THIS ORDINANCE** is passed and adopted this 28<sup>th</sup> day of September, 2010.
