## ORDINANCE #10-58:

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER VII OF THE PINEHURST MUNICIPAL CODE AS IT PERTAINS TO THE REQUIREMENTS OF GOLF CARTS OPERATED ON PUBLIC ROADS IN THE VILLAGE OF PINEHURST.

**THAT, WHEREAS,** the Village Council of the Village of Pinehurst adopted an ordinance dated October 20, 1980, establishing and implementing certain authorized police powers for the purpose of prescribing regulations governing conditions detrimental to the health, safety, and welfare of its citizens; and

WHERAS, the Municipal Code has been subsequently amended from time to time as conditions warrant; and

WHEREAS, the Village Council of the Village of Pinehurst finds that allowing for the use of golf carts on public streets should be done in the safest means possible;

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ESTABLISHED** by the Village Council of Pinehurst, North Carolina, in work session assembled this 16 day of November, 2010 as follows:

**SECTION 1.** That Chapter VII of the Pinehurst Municipal Code is hereby amended by altering Sections 7-4.4b.7, 7-4.4b.9 and 7-4.4b.10 as follows:

## 7-4.4 Operation of Golf Carts on Public Streets and Roads.

7. Golf carts may be operated only during daylight hours, with the exception of golf carts meeting the requirements set forth below which may operate for one (1) hour before sunrise and one (1) hour past sunset:

Two (2) lighted lamps, one (1) on each side of the front of the golf cart <u>or a front-mounted halogen light bar specifically designed for cart use</u>, visible under normal atmospheric conditions from a distance of at least three hundred (300) feet in front of such golf cart, and two red lamps on the rear, one on each side, exhibiting a red light visible under like conditions from a distance of at least two hundred (200) feet to the rear of such golf cart.

**SECTION 2.** That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its adoption.
