

**ORDINANCE #09-01:**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING FUNDS FOR OPERATIONS OF THE VILLAGE OF PINEHURST, REGARDING REVENUES AND EXPENDITURES OF THE GENERAL FUND FOR THE VILLAGE OF PINEHURST, NORTH CAROLINA (RECYCLING HAULING CONTRACTED SERVICES).**

**THAT WHEREAS,** participation in the Village’s recycling program has nearly doubled in the last eighteen (18) months; and

**WHEREAS,** the Public Services department hauls on average between 10 and 14 loads of recyclables a month to Raleigh, or spends between 30 and 42 hours per month hauling; and

**WHEREAS,** management would like to redeploy Village staff to perform other tasks; and

**WHEREAS,** Village staff estimates it is more economical for a local contractor to haul the recyclables to Raleigh at a cost of \$39 per ton;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Village Council of the Village of Pinehurst, North Carolina, in work session assembled this 13<sup>th</sup> day of January 2009, as follows:

**SECTION 1.** To amend the General Fund with regard to revenues and expenditures, the revenue and expenditure accounts are to be changed as follows:
