AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING FUNDS FOR OPERATIONS OF THE VILLAGE OF PINEHURST, REGARDING REVENUES AND EXPENDITURES OF THE PUBLIC SERVICES FACILITY CAPITAL PROJECT FUND AND THE CAPITAL RESERVE FUND FOR THE VILLAGE OF PINEHURST, NORTH CAROLINA.
