ORDINANCE #08-07:

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SCHEDULE IV OF SECTION 7-3.5 OF THE PINEHURST MUNICIPAL CODE AS IT PERTAINS TO PARKING IN THE VILLAGE OF PINEHURST

THAT WHEREAS, the Village Council has established parking regulations throughout the corporate limits; and

WHEREAS, the Village Code of Ordinances gives the Village Council the ability to create and provide parking in public rights-of-way; and

WHEREAS, the Village's Municipal Code currently indicates that parking on designated Village streets is allowed subject to certain designated time limits; and

WHEREAS, changing conditions have required review of certain parking areas; and

WHEREAS, a study was conducted by Village staff analyzing the costs and benefits of continuing the regulation of overtime parking in the Core Village;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ESTABLISHED by the Village Council of Pinehurst, North Carolina, in work session assembled this 11th day of March, 2008 as follows:

SECTION 1. That Schedule IV of Section 7-3.5 of the Pinehurst Municipal Code is hereby amended as follows:
