

ORDINANCE #08-30:

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING FUNDS FOR OPERATIONS OF THE VILLAGE OF PINEHURST, REGARDING REVENUES AND EXPENDITURES OF THE JACKSON HAMLET CDBG CAPITAL PROJECT FUND AND THE CAPITAL RESERVE FUND FOR THE VILLAGE OF PINEHURST, NORTH CAROLINA.

THAT WHEREAS, the Village adopted Ordinance #07-11 to establish a capital project fund to accumulate the costs associated with the Jackson Hamlet Sewer Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) project; and,

WHEREAS, the County of Moore has agreed to increase their local match appropriation by \$1,500 for this project in order to fund additional costs associated with sewer construction; and,

WHEREAS, the Village desires to reduce their local match appropriation for this project by the same amount and return the funds to the Capital Reserve Fund;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Village Council of the Village of Pinehurst, North Carolina, in a work session assembled this 7th day of October, 2008, as follows:

SECTION 1. To amend the Jackson Hamlet Sewer CDBG Project Fund with regard to revenues and expenditures, the revenue and expenditure accounts are to be changed as follows:
