

**ORDINANCE #07-24:**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING FUNDS FOR OPERATIONS OF THE VILLAGE OF PINEHURST, REGARDING REVENUES AND EXPENDITURES OF THE GENERAL FUND FOR THE VILLAGE OF PINEHURST, NORTH CAROLINA (HIGHWAY SAFETY GRANT)**

THAT WHEREAS, the purpose for which some appropriations in the FY 2007-2008 Budget were authorized have changed, necessitating the addition of funds from other sources; and

WHEREAS, the Village Police Department has been awarded continuation funding from the North Carolina Governor's Highway Safety Program for the purpose of maintaining a traffic enforcement unit which was established in FY 2006-07 to aggressively enforce NC motor vehicle laws and educate the public on motor vehicle safety issues; and

WHEREAS, the Village did not originally budget for this grant and desires to make use of the funds to support the Governor's Highway Safety Program as proposed for the Village of Pinehurst;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Village Council of the Village of Pinehurst, North Carolina, in work session assembled this 24<sup>th</sup> day of July, 2007, as follows:

SECTION 1. To amend the General Fund with regard to revenues and expenditures, the revenue and expenditure accounts are to be changed as follows:
