

ORDINANCE #06-10:

AN ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF PINEHURST EXTENDING A MORATORIUM ON REAL ESTATE DEVELOPMENT ACTIVITY IN A SPECIFIC AREA WITHIN THE VILLAGE OF PINEHURST.

THAT WHEREAS, the Village of Pinehurst, North Carolina adopted an ordinance (#05-36) imposing a Moratorium on Real Estate Development Activity in a specific area within the Village of Pinehurst on November 22, 2005; and

WHEREAS, said ordinance specifies that the moratorium as detailed in the original ordinance may be extended once for a period of 90 days duration; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the Village of Pinehurst has determined that extending the moratorium would aid in the accomplishment of the aims as detailed in the original ordinance;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED AND ESTABLISHED, by the Village Council of the Village of Pinehurst, North Carolina in Work Session assembled this 9th day of May, 2006, as follows:

Section 1. That the moratorium imposed by ordinance on November 22, 2005 is hereby extended for a period of 90 days from the date of expiration of the original ordinance, thus to expire on August 18, 2006.

Section 2. That all sections of the original ordinance remain in full effect throughout the days of this extension.
