

ORDINANCE #06-26:

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SCHEDULE I OF SECTION 7 OF THE PINEHURST MUNICIPAL CODE AS IT PERTAINS TO PARKING IN THE VILLAGE OF PINEHURST.

THAT WHEREAS, the Village Council of the Village of Pinehurst has previously enacted an ordinance on the sixteenth of January, 1984, prohibiting parking on certain streets and parts of streets, those streets codified as Schedule I of Section 7 of the Pinehurst Municipal Code; and

WHEREAS, said Section of the Code has been subsequently amended from time to time as conditions warrant; and

WHEREAS, it has been reported to the police and it has been observed that motor vehicles are parked at times on the right of way of Quail Run in a manner which causes traffic congestion and damage to the right of way area; and

WHEREAS, the Board of the Homeowners' Association of Clarendon Gardens has requested that the Village of Pinehurst enact an ordinance prohibiting parking alongside and within the entry median of Clarendon Gardens (Quail Run); and

WHEREAS, the Council deems it necessary to prohibit parking on portions of the right of way of Quail Run to prevent vehicles from being parked along the sides of and within the entry median to Clarendon Gardens; and

WHEREAS, the Village Council has determined that it is in the Health, Safety, and Welfare interests of both the guests and of the citizens of Pinehurst to prohibit parking at these locations;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ESTABLISHED by the Village Council of the Village of Pinehurst, North Carolina, in working session assembled this 26th day of September, 2006, as follows:

SECTION 1. That Schedule I - NO PARKING of Chapter 7 of the Pinehurst Municipal Code is hereby amended by adding the following:

<u>Street</u>	<u>Side</u>	<u>Location</u>
Quail Run Entrance	East	From Linden Road to Quail Run (Loop Road)
Quail Run Exit	West	From Quail Run (Loop Road) to Linden Road

SECTION 2. That all ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed and declared null and void from and after the date of adoption of this ordinance.

SECTION 3. That this Ordinance shall be and remain in full force and effect from and after the date of its adoption and the erection of the appropriate traffic signs.

SECTION 4. That the Chief of Police and Public Works Director are hereby authorized and directed to establish appropriate signage at the places designated in Section 1 of this ordinance, for the purpose of enforcement of this ordinance.

SECTION 5. Adopted this 26th day of September, 2006.
