Green Guidelines

Cooking oil and kitchen grease is a more efficient fuel than gasoline! Local restaurants sell used cooking oil for production of biofuel.

Do not pour cooking oil or kitchen grease down your drain. It can clog your household pipes and county sewers.

Reduce consumption and save money by pouring warm used cooking oil through a coffee filter and storing in the refrigerator for re-use.

How to Dispose of Cooking Oil & Renderings

• Keep a re-usable container to collect your used oil and renderings. Pinehurst Recycling Partners have large tanks in which they collect their kitchen grease and oil for collection by a biofuel distiller. They accept your oil & grease but require that you take your empty container home. Also, please separate out water from your oil & grease. Keep in mind that tanks are located in a utility area and safety is your responsibility.
