Green Guidelines

Reduce global mining operations, extraction processing and smelting. Recycle scrap metal such as aluminum, brass, copper, iron and steel. The environmental impact and cost of turning scrap metal into feedstock for manufacturing is lower than the cost to extract metals and process them into raw material.

General Guidelines

Waste metal that accumulates around the house is valuable because it requires less processing to be used as manufacturing feedstock than raw minerals and ore, but the recycling process is specialized so contact one or more of our Recycling Partners to be sure they handle what you have to dispose of.
