Green Guidelines

Reduce tire wear (and prolong the life of your tires) with regular inflation, balancing, and rotation.

Re-Use tires with remaining useful life by re-treading.

Recycle worn-out tires because they are raw material for highway construction and many other uses, such as playground “tiles”, tire swings, go-cart tracks, or garden planters.

General Guidelines

Tire Dealers generally accept tires for recycling “1-for-1” upon your purchase of new tires. Exceptions are noted in the Pinehurst Recycling Partners section. Tires from all dealers are only accepted during business hours. A fee may be charged for disposal of tires. Please check with the dealer.
