PINEHURST COURSE NO. 2 RESTORATION



- Completed in March of 2011
- Removed 30 35 acres of turf
- Approximately 650 sprinkler heads were eliminated, leaving 450 operational resulting in over 50% reduction in water use
- Fairway widths were increased by roughly 50%
- Length increased to 7,485 yards




