adult area and more space for adult nonfiction and fiction. Given Memorial Library will also be the site of the Pinehurst Hall of Fame, which will hold its inaugural event in November 2013. In addition, the building expansion will include a large meeting room that will provide space for various types of events and programs.

From the earliest days, the Village of Pinehurst has had a lending library provided through the benevolence and good will of the Tufts family. In 1964, Sarah Given Larson created this lasting treasure in memory of her parents, John and Irene Heinz Given. With an endowment in their honor, and a gift of land on the Village Green by Richard S. Tufts, the Given Memorial Library was born. Ten years later, the Tufts Archives was created through an endowment from the Tufts Family Foundation and the Pinehurst history museum was added. Now, the Given Memorial Library is almost fifty years old and is a central and beloved part of the Village of Pinehurst.

While Pinehurst's population has grown,



The 150 hour program in Municipal Administration is designed for managers,

department heads, and officials whose responsibilities require a broad understanding of functions beyond individual areas of specialization. Community Appearance Grant Program

The Community Appearance Grant Program helps businesses and property owners in commercial areas upgrade and improve the exterior appearance of their property. Recent grant recipient, Potpourri, was able to enhance the store's exterior trim with a fresh coat of paint. Potpourri's owner, Eldora Wood, bought the building in 1980 and was awarded 38% of the total cost of the project, totaling \$1,500, through the Village's Community Appearance Grant.
