- 3) 22" mixed greenery- \$27.00
- 4) 26" mixed greenery- \$32.00

In addition, red bows may be ordered at \$5.00 for a small bow and \$8.00 for a large one. Purchased wreaths may be picked up at the Fire Station on Magnolia Road on Tuesday, November 30<sup>th</sup> from 10 am to 2 pm and from 4 pm to 6 pm. Please bring your copy of the order form to make sure you pick up the correct order.

Profits from this wreath sale are used by the Beautification Committee to help fund decorations throughout the Village.
