- Council unanimously approved Resolution 16-26 appointing Kevin Drum and Cyndie Burnett to the Planning and Zoning Board and Board of Adjustment effective December 1, 2016.
- Council unanimously approved Resolution 16-27 appointing Bert Higgins, Jack Wood, Sherri Sabo, Molly Rowell, and Larry Cox to the Pinehurst Appearance Committee.
- Council unanimously approved the Special Intensity Allocation for Pinehurst Senior Apartments located at 4176 Murdocksville Road as outlined in the memorandum prepared and submitted by the Pinehurst Planning and Inspections Department dated October 18, 2016.
- Council held a Public Hearing to consider an Official Text Amendment to the Pinehurst Development Ordinance, specifically Section 9.2a, "Table of Dimensional Standards", in order to reduce the required minimum lot width at the street line in the Public Conservation (PC) Zoning District from 100-feet to 50-feet.
- Council unanimously approved Ordinance 16-17 amending the Pinehurst Development Ordinance Section 9.2A Table of Dimensional Requirements for the Village of Pinehurst and that the proposed amendments to the Pinehurst Development Ordinance are consistent with the goals outlined in the 2010 Comprehensive Long Range Plan and are considered reasonable and in the best interest of the public as referenced in the memorandum dated October 18, 2016 from Kevin Reed, Director of Planning and Inspections.
- Jeff Batton, Assistant Village Manager, presented the Grounds Maintenance BIRDIE Report.
- Council unanimously approved the land swap with Moore County for the county owned land adjacent to the Public Services yard and the Village owned 4.42 acres on Juniper Lake Road contingent upon review and approval of the final plat by Village Manager and Village Attorney.
- John Frye Financial Services Director, presented the Village's financial statements for the quarter ending September 30, 2016.
- Council unanimously approved Ordinance 16-18 amending the budget for the Village of Pinehurst to purchase a new water truck for the Harness Track.
- Council unanimously approved the official schedule for the 2017 Village Council meetings.
